MINUTE ENTRY

The Court has again received and reviewed a Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel and for Sanctions, filed February 4, 2022. This appears to be yet another disclosure or discovery dispute in the case. As the Court has previously informed Plaintiffs multiple times (via Minute Entry filed December 14, 2021 in the first instance), this Court requires strict compliance with Ariz. R. Civ. P. 26(d) regarding discovery and disclosure disputes. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED denying the Motion to Compel and for Sanctions with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall file no further Motions to Compel and/or for Sanctions without leave of Court. Should Plaintiffs fail to obey this Order, the Court will set an Order to Show Cause hearing to discuss appropriate sanctions to be issued to Plaintiffs pursuant to Ariz. R. Civ. P. 37(h).
